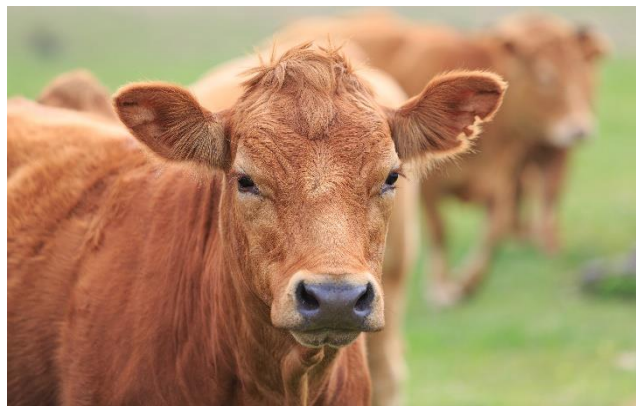

Definitely no late entries - No phone entries accepted. To be made on prescribed form available from the Secretary or on website. Tattoo/herdbook number to be shown on Entry Form.

To celebrate 150 years Cattle entries will be free for 2024 courtesy of Steve King.

**Rules:**

1. Johne's Disease Cattle – Entries will be accepted from NJDMAP Assessed Herds and from non-assessed herds. Separation requirements as determined by the Australian Johne's Disease Market Assurance Program will apply at the show. For details refer to the Nowra Show Society Cattle Entry Form.
2. All animals shown must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor.
3. The age of dairy cattle to be taken as at 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2024.
4. All cattle must be under control and all must be led around the judging ring.
5. Cattle shown in pens or group classes must have competed singularly in another appropriate class.
6. It is compulsory for all cattle to be entered according to their date of birth on registration.
7. Cow entered as dry will be allowed to compete as cow in milk (if calved).
8. Exhibitors are requested to ensure that attendants are neatly dressed. Shorts permissible if accompanied by shirt, socks and shoes.
9. Where animals are owned jointly or in syndicates, points for Most Successful Exhibitor or Breeder Trophies, to be awarded to the names jointly or to the syndicate, not divided between the owners individually.
10. 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Place getters from eligible classes will parade for Champion.
11. Most Successful Exhibitor points will be awarded on the basis of:

Champion	5 points
Reserve Champion	2 points
1 <sup>st</sup> Prize	3 points
2 <sup>nd</sup> Prize	2 points
3 <sup>rd</sup> Prize	1 point
12. Prizes may be awarded in Cash or Vouchers to equivalent value.
13. Paraders competition will be held before breed classes.
14. Exhibitors may substitute an entry as long as it is in the same class. Nowra Show Society member to be notified no later than 30 minutes before the start of the breed's judging.
15. Stakes and Star post are not to be driven into the ground unless authorised by Show Society member.

**Judging:** Judging commences at 9 am Friday 9<sup>th</sup> February with Parader Classes.  
Holstein and Coloured Breeds commences at 9.30am.

Shorts permissible if accompanied by shirt, socks and shoes.

NSW Legislation requires a travelling stock statement for all stock movements.

It is recommended tat all exhibits be tested negative for Pestivirus.

All bulls over 12 months must be kept under control by and led by a nose ring, the handlers of bulls must be over sixteen yrs of age.

All Class winners, Champions and Reserve Champions are requested to participate in the Grand Parade to be held in the main showground at the completion of the Beef Judging at the cattle lawn. Participants in the Grand Parade will be eligible for a lucky dip prize.

Stakes and Star post are not to be driven into the ground unless authorised by show society member.

The class is for a steer showing NO permanent teeth, to be prepared and exhibited by a fulltime school student or exhibitor under 18 yrs of age as at 30th June, 2024. The steer and handler must be the same for each show in this class.

To be judged taking into consideration student handling and knowledge. The beef sub-committee recommends that the competition be judged the 1st steer class on the day. Results to be withheld and announced at the completion of the steer judging. Points to be awarded to a maximum of 10 placings and each competitor receive 10 points for attendance. Competitors in the ECM Livestock Junior Steer Competition are encouraged to exhibit in other open steer classes that may be scheduled on the day. Where schools are exhibiting other students may parade the steer competing in the Junior Steer Competition in an open class.

### **Commercial Classes**

#### **Commercial Competition Rules:**

Open to commercial cattle only. Cattle should be from recognized Beef breeds. Crossbreeds are to be beef cattle crosses only. No female that is eligible to compete in the Stud Section will be eligible to compete in the Commercial Competition.

No entire male calves are eligible to compete. All exhibits should be stalled on the western side of the cattle lawn unless tested negative for PestVirus (certificate to be provided). Animals must be tractable and led (with a nose ring) for judging.
